3.) Information Sharing

The cooperation between other Government Agencies within the Intelligence Community (IC) and the FBI has resulted in significant improvements in the conduct of everyone's mission. has prepared FISA requests in two separate matters based on information from the IC. Three potential compromises in ongoing foreign intelligence investigations were averted through the timely sharing of information. Numerous IT cases benefitted from the receipt of intelligence from the IC and vice versa. Follow-up investigations have been coordinated with the IC when FBI - IT subjects have departed the U.S., whether the departure was voluntary or not. Numerous IIRs disseminating foreign intelligence and/or positive terrorism intelligence have been generated.
